1. There will be **6 Shooting Events** held throughout the MHSRA 2017-2018 rodeo season. These shoots will be held at Lamar County Shooting Sports Complex, co-hosted by MHSRA and Lamar County 4-H. The State Finals Shooting Events will be held during the week of MS High School Finals Rodeo.
2. Contestant is required to enter and compete at a **minimum of 3** of these Shoots to be eligible to enter and compete in Shooting at the State Finals.
3. **DOCUMENTATION or PROOF of TRAINING: CERTIFIED 4-H SHOOTING SAFETY or HUNTER SAFETY EDUCATION or NRA RIFLE FIRST STEPS or NRA BASICS of RIFLE/SHOTGUN will be MANDATORY BEFORE THE SCHEDULED JANUARY 13, 2018 Shoot.**

4. Contestant must meet all NHSRA and MHSRA membership requirements in order to enter the Shooting at any of these events. Visit [www.mshsra.org](http://www.mshsra.org) and [www.nhsra.com](http://www.nhsra.com) for membership forms and regulations.
5. The Rodeo Association offers Light Rifle .22 competition for Jr. High (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade) and High School (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade) contestants and Trap Shotgun competition for High School (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade) contestants. 6. Entry Forms will be posted at [www.mshsra.org](http://www.mshsra.org). The current entry fee for the Shooting Events is **\$15.00 per event per shoot plus a \$5.00 awards fee and \$5.00 office fee per shoot for non-rodeo contestants.**
7. There will be a certified range safety officer present at the shooting events to guide you and score the targets.
8. Points will be awarded to the top 10 Contestants placing in Light Rifle and top 10 Contestants placing in Trap Shooting. Boys and Girls will compete in the same shooting events.
9. All points earned at these Shooting events plus points earned at the State Finals Shooting events will count toward year end points to determine the top 4 Contestants in Light Rifle and the top 4 in Trap Shooting who will earn year end awards and qualify to compete at the National High School Finals Rodeo.
